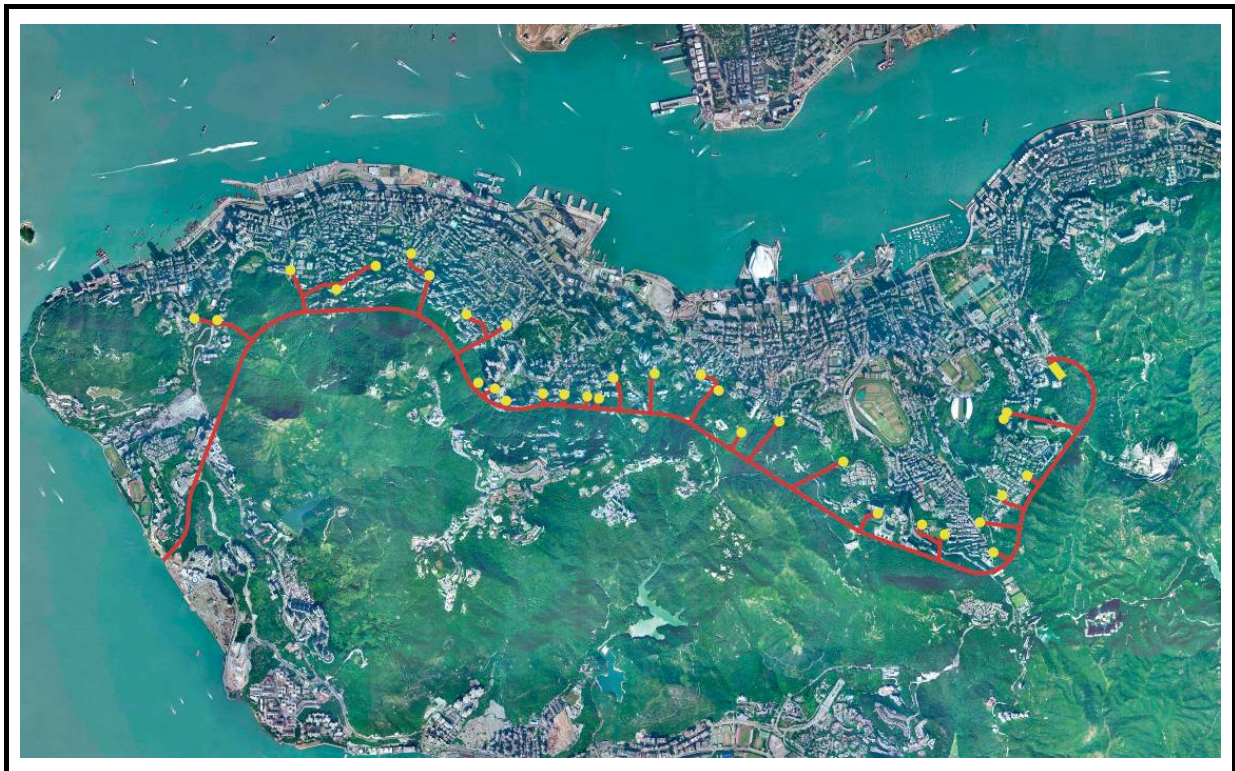




ANNOUNCEMENT
AGS(HK) Technical Visit to

**“DSD Contract DC/2007/10 – Design and Construction
of Hong Kong West Drainage Tunnel”**



Date : Saturday, 30th April 2011

Programme Highlights :

The project consists of building a main drainage tunnel of about 11km long extending from Tai Hang to Cyberport, 34 intakes and a total of about 8km adits connecting the intakes with the drainage tunnel at a project cost of HK\$3,044.7M. The newly built drainage tunnel will intercept and convey stormwater from uphill at Mid-Levels to the sea near Cyberport. The construction work commenced in

November 2007. The project is being carried out in phases and is due for completion in 2012.

The main tunnel will be constructed by two double shields Tunnel Boring Machines (TBMs) while adit will mainly be excavated by drill and blast method. Most of the rock excavation at intakes shaft will be carried out underground by using the Raise Boring Machine (RBM) to minimise nuisance at ground level due to spoil disposal. Attendees to this technical site visit will have an opportunity to gain insights into the ongoing construction works.

The number of participants is strictly limited. Priority will be given to members of the AGS(HK). The number of attendees will be limited to **25** and the applications will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Successful applicants will be informed about 1 week before the event. CPD certificate will be provided.
